Short Guidelines for the Authors of "Il Nuovo Saggiatore"

Papers should be written in a clear and simple way, in order to be understandable also to non-specialists. Therefore formalisms (especially long and cumbersome equations) should be limited to a minimum.

If necessary, boxes can be used to disentangle more technical parts from the main text.

The paper should be prepared EXCLUSIVELY using Microsoft Word in a plain style, without using too many different characters or personalizations that could disappear in the conversion to the production software.

The files to be submitted are: article.doc, article.pdf; the figures (.eps, .tif, .jpg, pdf) and tables do not need to be paginated, and can also be provided as separate files.

The text must include the following elements:

- <u>Title:</u> it should be short, immediately comprehensible and appealing. To limit its length, an additional subtitle line can be added if necessary (example: UNIQUE AND EXCITING NANOSTRUCTURES Electronic and optoelectronic nanodevices based on carbon nanotubes).
 - <u>Author(s)</u> with first name(s) written in full and complete <u>affiliation(s)</u>.
 - Brief highlight of the content: (maximum 100 words/~ 700 characters).
- <u>Main text:</u> the maximum length should be about 6000 words/~ 40000 characters (not including tables and figures); it may be divided into numbered sections and subsections if necessary.
- <u>Figures:</u> they must be of good quality and high resolution; coloured and attracting images should be preferred to plain graphics in black and white. The captions should be clear and self-explaining, i.e. understandable also without reading the main text.
- <u>References</u>: should be limited in number (in alternative a list of books or reviews on the subject can be provided) and should be complete in all their parts (journals: author(s), journal title, volume number, year, page; books: author(s) or editor(s), title, publisher, city and year).
 - References, figures and tables: should all be quoted in sequential number in the main text.
 - Brief profile of the author: (maximum 100 words/~ 700 characters).
