FULL CITATION

5) REFEREES

The proposer, before completing this form, should seek the co-operation of up to three referees, at least one of whom must be external to the nominee's place of work (they need not be from international institutions). Referees will be asked to provide a supporting statement of no more than 300 words to complement the citation provided by the proposer.

Referees need not be a physics expert but should be familiar with the work of the nominee as indicated in the citation and be able to comment on the significance of the nominee's contribution. They will also be asked to confirm the accuracy of the information provided by the proposer. To assist referees the first two pages of the nomination form and the terms of the award will be sent to them, along with a list of previous recipients.

For a nomination to be considered by the SIF Council at least two supporting statements must be received. The Society will contact referees to request supporting statements after the nomination has been submitted.

The deadline for receipt of supporting statements is **27 May 2022 (new deadline)**.
